

## Irving, Texas Heritage District

The Heritage District of Irving is considered, "Downtown Irving." With Main Street, and the Transit Station only blocks from the South Irving Library.

The Library is across the street from the old Central Library, a large fountain and adjacent to Centennial Park.

### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

**From the North** – Exit Hwy 183 at MacArthur Blvd and drive south to Schultz Drive, just after crossing the TRE line. Turn left on Schultz Drive to the Library parking lot on your right.

Note: Schultz Dr. has no traffic light. Look for crosswalk and John Haley Elementary School on your left.

**From the South** – Exit I-30 on MacArthur Blvd and drive North to Schulz Drive (North of 6<sup>th</sup> St and just prior to TRE Line.) Right on Schultz Drive to the Library parking lot on your right.

Note: Schultz Dr. has no traffic light. Look for crosswalk at John Haley Elementary School on your right

### Via TRE / DART

Exit at the South Irving TRE Transit Station.

(Station is across the street from a McDonalds Restaurant.)

Walk towards the McDonalds and continue to the street just past the McDonalds parking lot. (Second Street.)

Turn right on Second Street. After crossing a bridge turn left on Schultz Dr. crossing Second Street. Continue a short distance to the South Irving Library parking lot on your left.

### AREA YEAR ROUND EVENTS (YREs)

Make it a long weekend and take part in the four YREs in Fort Worth (Downtown YRE), Plano (Arber Hills YRE) and Dallas (Uptown YRE).

**ELIGIBILITY/TYPE OF EVENT:** Noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. This event is open to all and families are encouraged to participate. Children under age 12 must be accompanied by an adult. Everyone **MUST** register and carry a Start Card and return it at the FINISH Table. This event is normally held regardless of weather conditions.

**STARTING POINT:** South Irving Library – Meeting Room “A”

**STARTING POINT ADDRESS:**

**START & FINISH TIMES:** 7:00am to 10:00am  
Finish by 1:00pm

**DISTANCES:** 10km (6.2mi)/5km (3.1mi).

The walk route may be walked TWICE on the same Start Card for 20km Distance Credit.

**AWARDS:** “A” Award and a series of “B” Awards from past events.

**FEES:** IVV Credit Only - \$3.00  
IVV Credit and “A” Award - \$8.00  
You may walk for FREE; however, you must sign-in and mark “FREE” on your Start Card and you will not be eligible for any IVV Credit or Awards.  
There is NO pre-registration and there will be NO Refunds.

**DONATIONS:** are most appreciated and are always welcome to help defray event expenses and promote volkssporting.

**WALK ROUTES:** The walk takes place in Dallas County. The routes are through the Heritage District of Old Irving, residential neighborhoods and several City Parks.

**RESTROOMS & WATER:** Restrooms and water are available at the Start & Finish. Restrooms are limited on the routes.

**PETS:** Pets are welcome but they **MUST BE** kept on a leash. They are **NOT** allowed in the Start & Finish (Irving Library) or in any public buildings / businesses with the exception of service animals.
